It's April, the season for April Fools. 'Fool' was an old word for clown or comedian (see Shakespeare) so the theme this month is **Comedians**. As there are 30 days in April, we have picked 15 comedy duos. The stage names of the 30 individuals are the answers you have to find. (You may need to look up some of their first names.) They are in alphabetical order of surname, which should help. There are 15 clues, which are clues to the duos. The clue numbers refer to the individual names that make up each pair.

Most of the comedians are British, but not all. Some only performed as a duo, others also had solo careers. Some are stand-up comedians, others are comedy actors and some are comedy musical duos. Some performed in all those roles.

- 23 and 29 Bringing sunshine to a seaside resort paired with sagacity
- 26 and 18 Frequent collaborators from "Not the Nine O'Clock News" onwards, but alas no more
- 30 and 28 Mainly solo performers but found together in canteen and antique shop
